

# Where the market is!

**S**türzt, the turn key supplier of machines and manufacturing systems for the pvcu window manufacturer says it is scoring again with cost effective solutions.

The new frame line will be shown for the first time at the Glassex exhibition. On show will be a Stürzt SE-HSM-6K horizontal six head welder connected to the new single head transom cleaner TC-MC-1H.

The single head corner cleaner is specially designed to clean frames with welded transom profiles and frames with profile combinations.

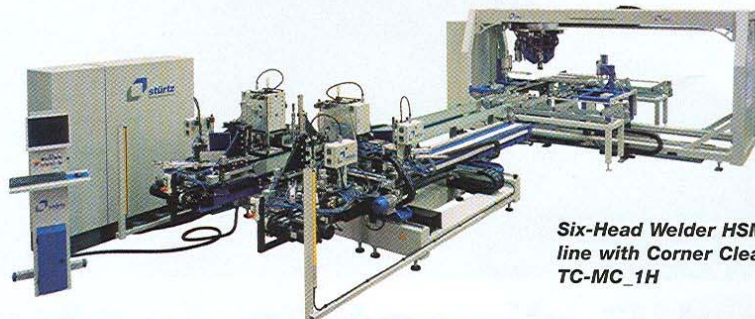
The highlight is the bridge system with 360° pivoted upper and lower machining units for positioning on profile corners without having to turn the square. Even transom and combination cleaning require no turning of the larger frames.

Flexible contour cleaning, freely programmable via an interactive PC control system and industrial keyboard with integrated touchpad and diagnosis system all round up an effective costs optimiser.

Options like an additional carriage for supporting transom crosses, overlap routing, data transfer and chip conveyor belts are available.

Frame dimensions from min. 380 x 350 mm up to 4,000 x 2,600 mm give the window manufacturer a large variety of sizes.

With the six axes TC-MC-1H Motion Control cleaner, frame production becomes extremely fast and efficient, the company says.
